

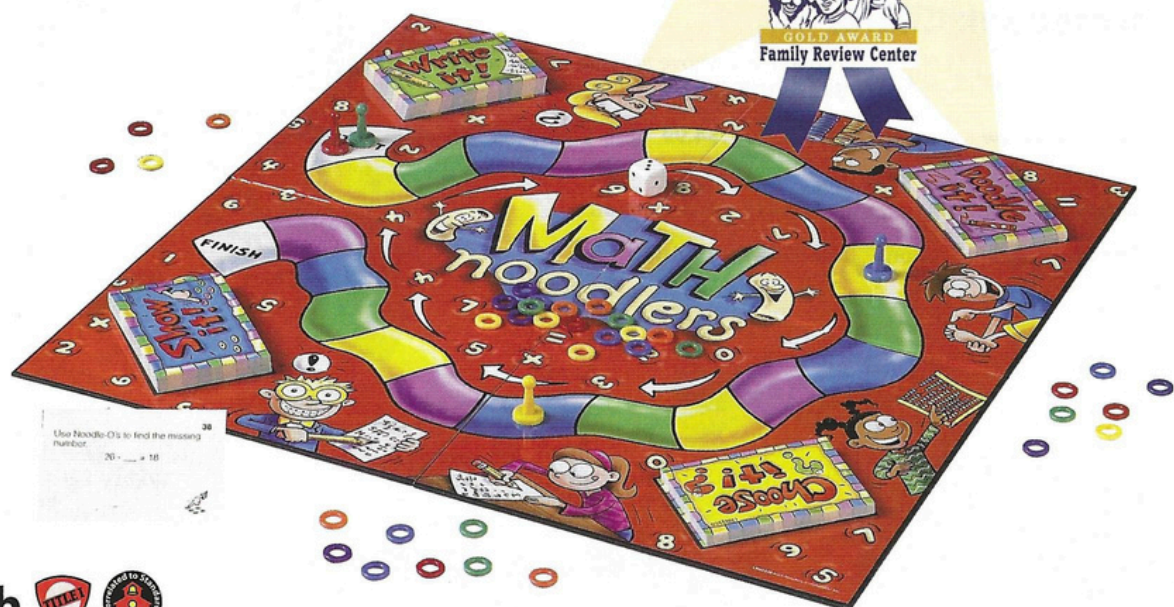
## NEW! Math Noodlers

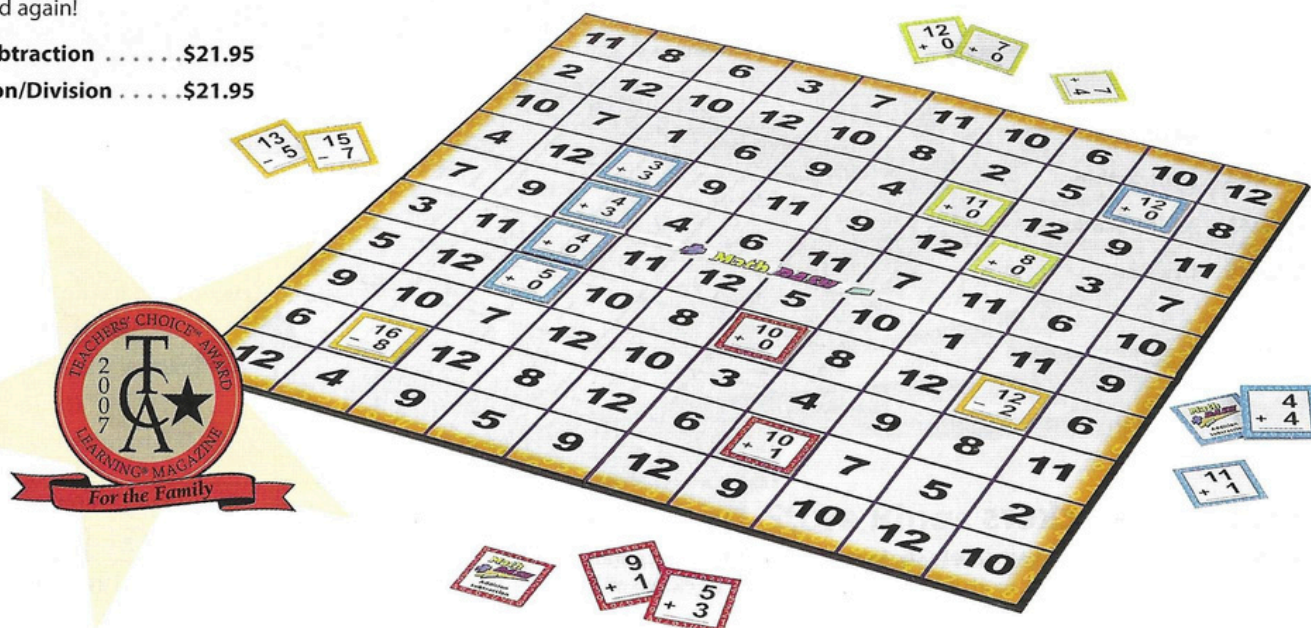
## NEW! Math Dash
